Bywood's Spring Music Concert!



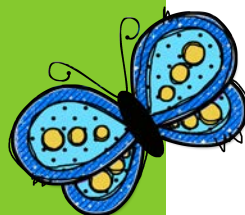
Congratulations to our Bywood Buddies, Singing ensemble, band and orchestra for a wonderful performance at our annual Spring concert!

Pictured above with our lovely music teacher, Dr. Kane are Samantha and Mariam showing their love after a wonderful show!



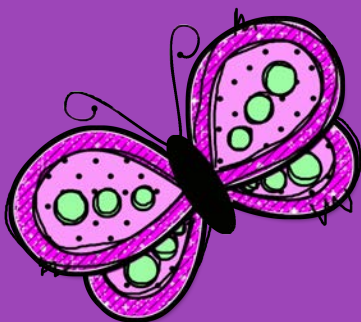
Bywood's EL Multicultural Fair & Upper Darby Arts Fest!
