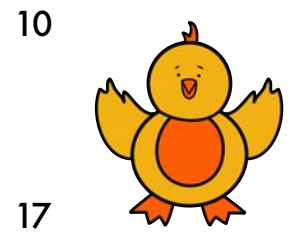

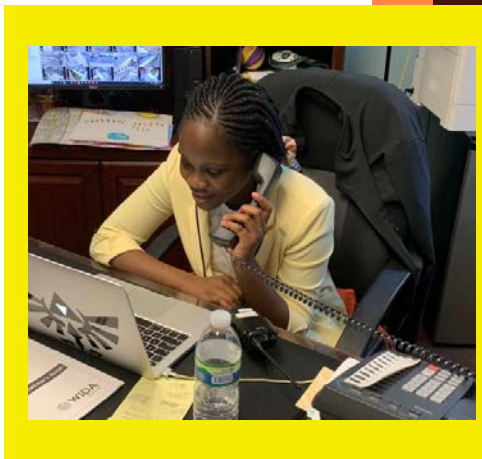


March Madness!
