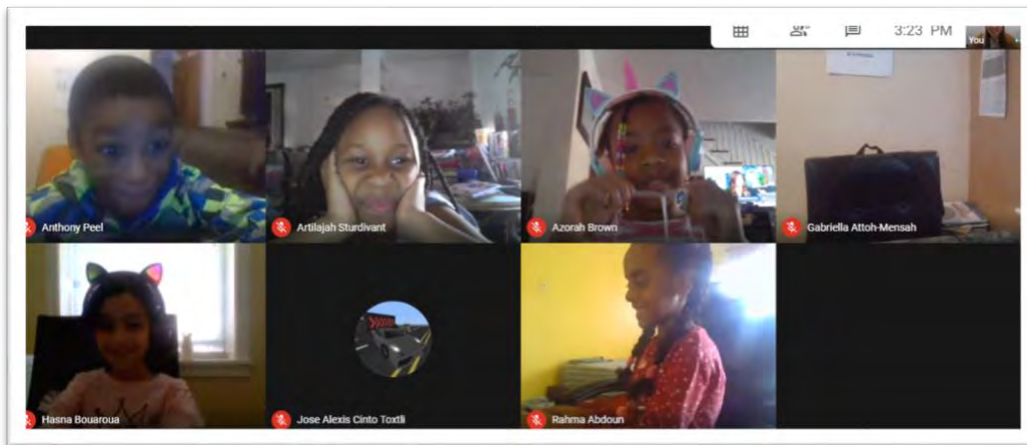

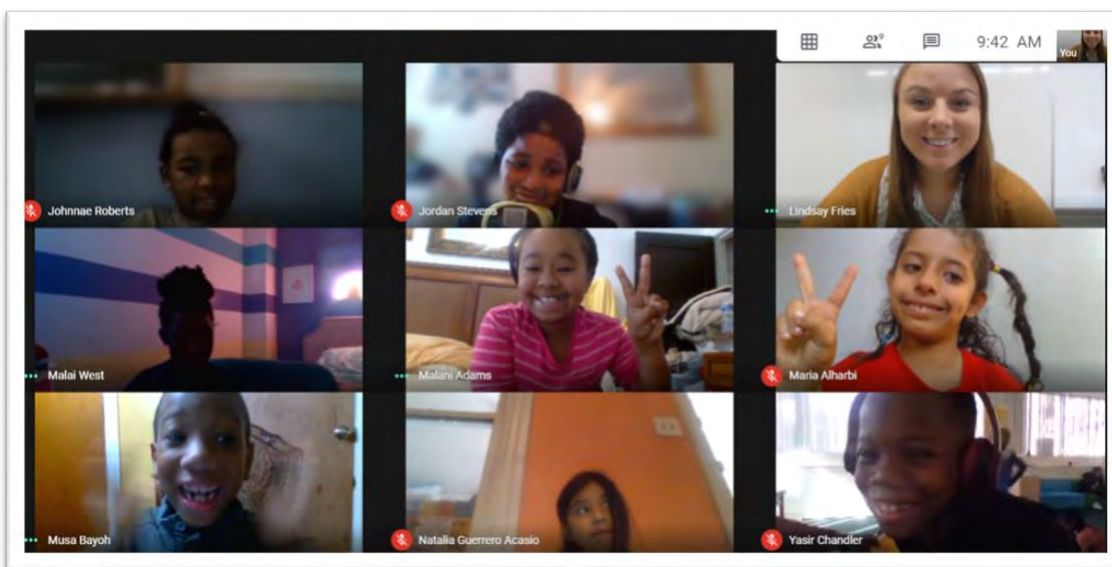

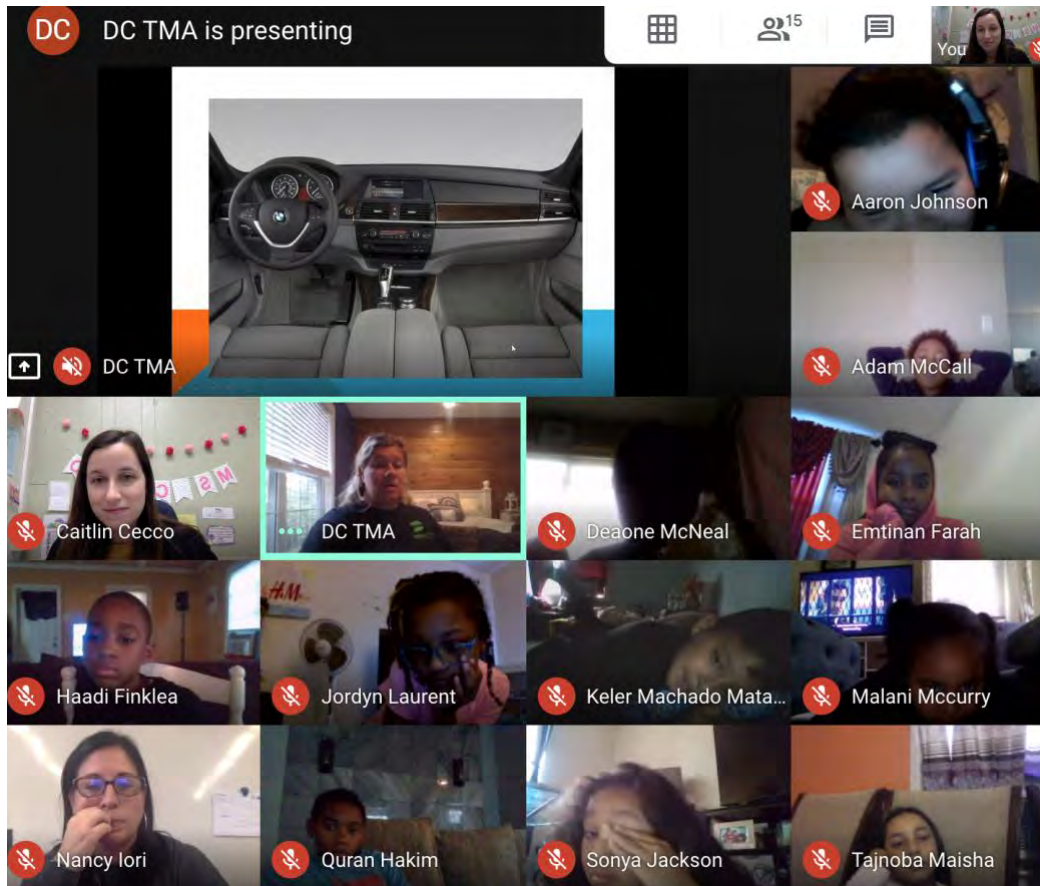
1st Grade talks about the November Character Trait: Citizenship!
