Q: What is your favorite dish that mom makes at home?


A: I love cooking with mom, our favorite thing to make is eggs with tortillas (you can see Kyara make this dish on our Flipgrid: b923db96)

Q: And what is your favorite thing about our school?




A: I love helping our first graders. And my favorite special is Art. I also like that everybody is so helpful here, especially Mrs. Iori.
