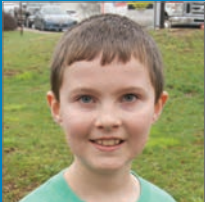
**LIZZY**

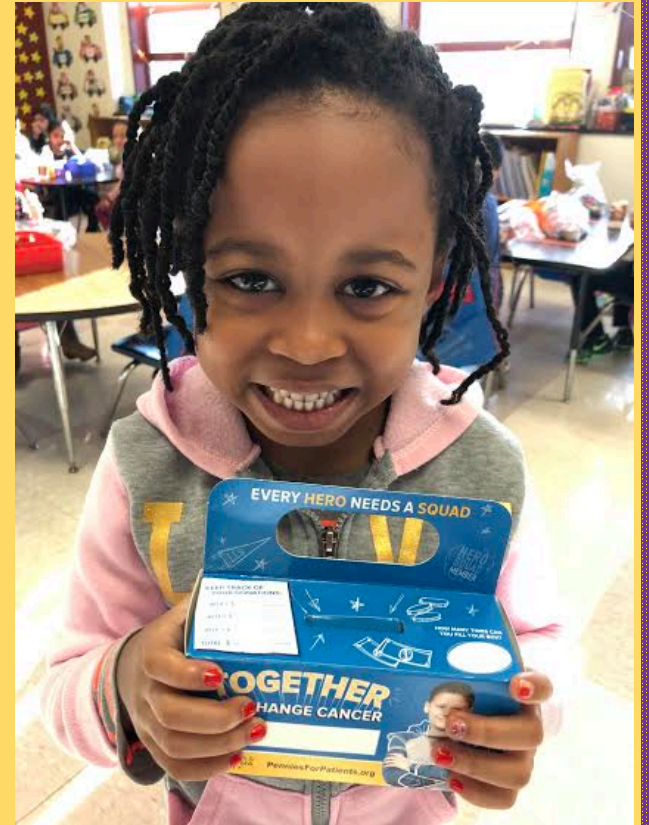
