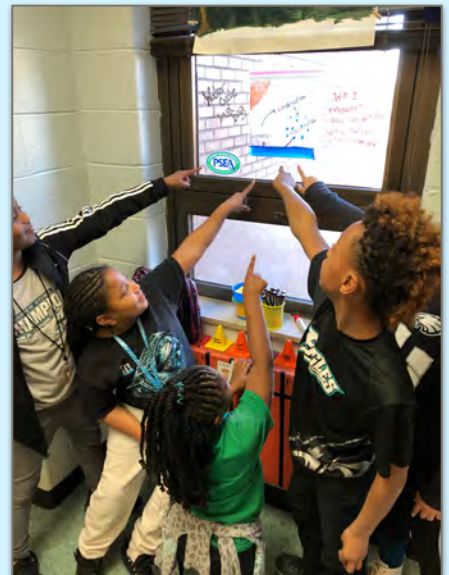
2nd Grade News
