Primos Basketball Club

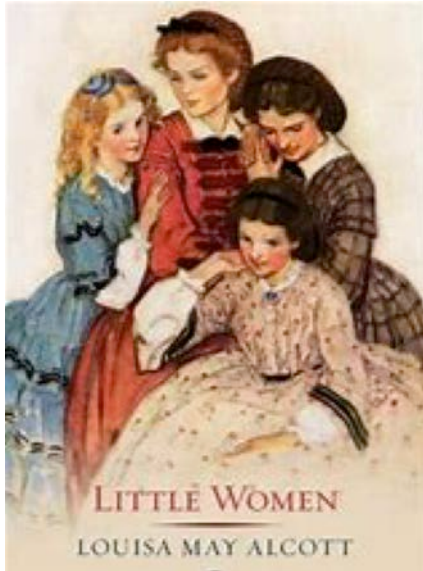
Coaches Mr. Papatsiaras and Mr. White
