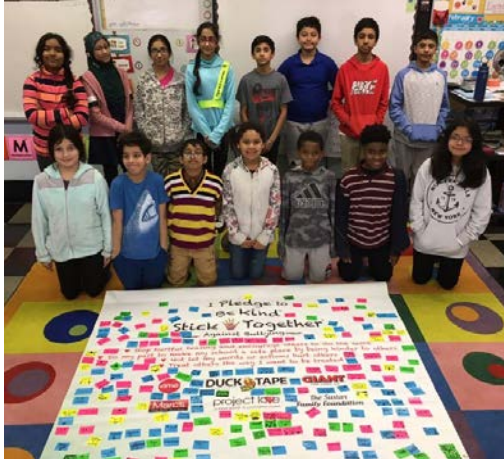

## Multi-Cultural Parade

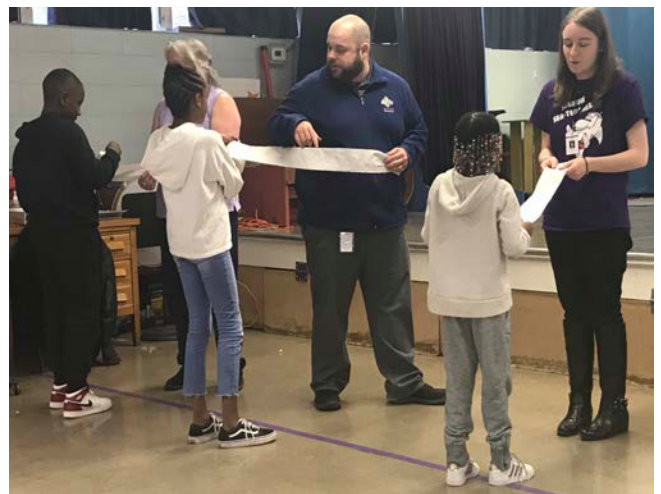
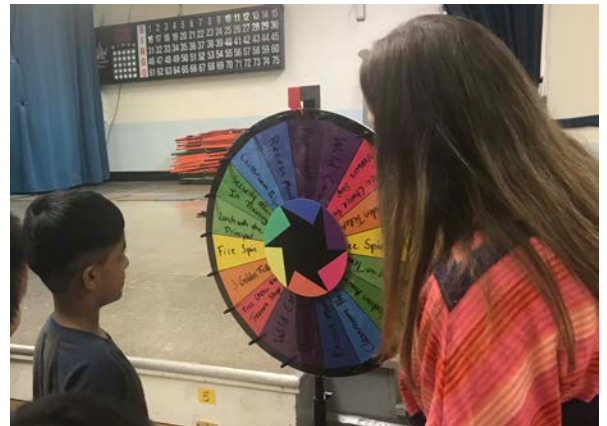


Students and staff paraded through the school dressed in multi-cultural attire. Everyone was able to experience cultures around the world.
