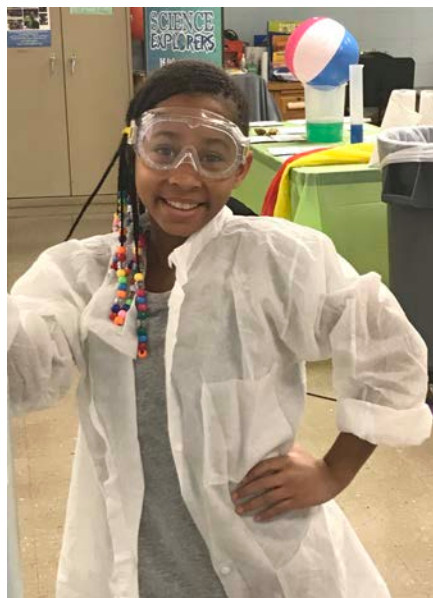

The "Science Explorers" assembly was educational and fun. We have many future scientists at Senkow!

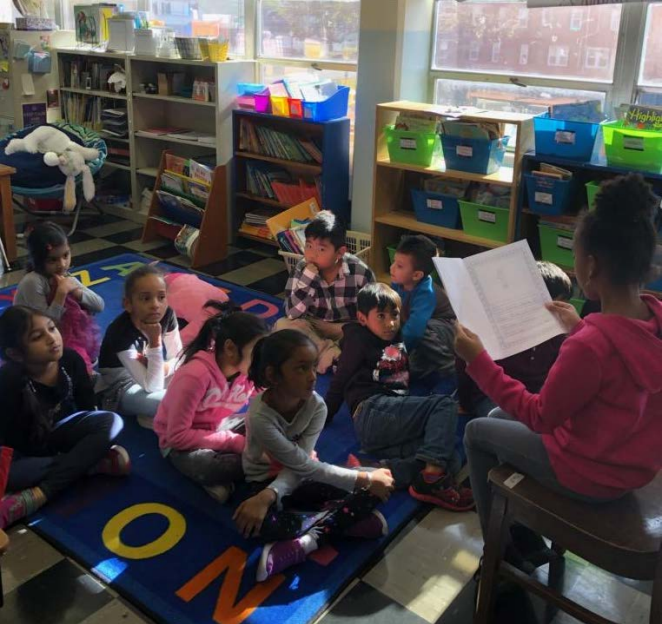


"Senkow Fall Festival 2019"

Senkow students, teachers, and staff celebrated Halloween with an indoor parade.



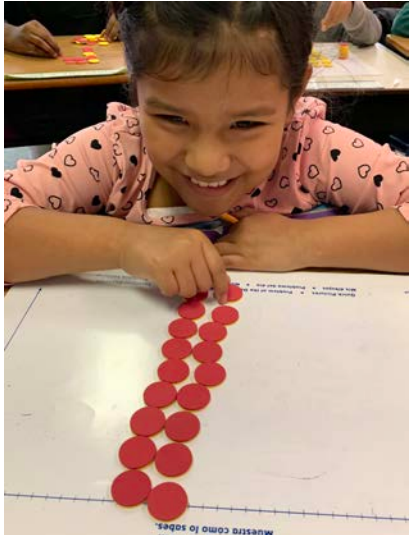
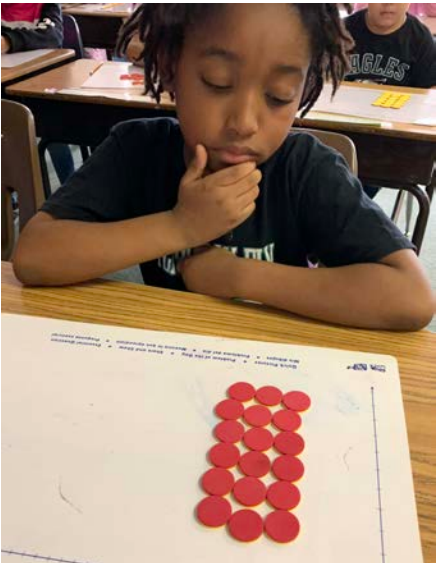
Ms. Bowden's first grade class shared their "All About Animals" research writing final drafts on Monday, November 4th.
