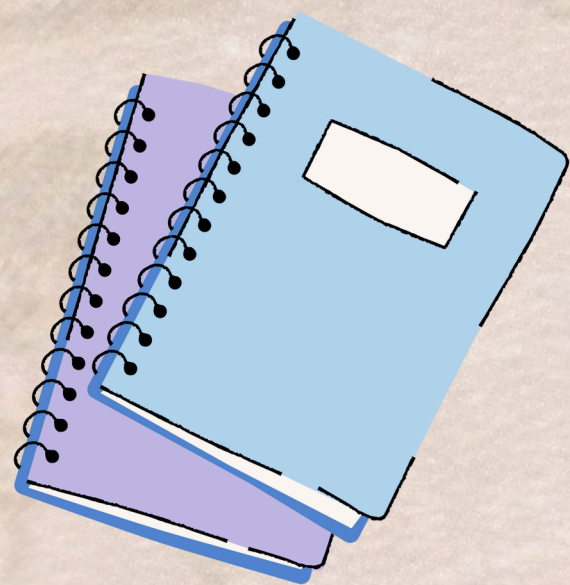
College Visits & Parents Chats!

The Class of 2026 counselors are hosting sessions where parents can join us to ask questions regarding post high school pathways. Please check your email for invites, dates, and more information!!

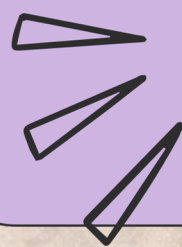
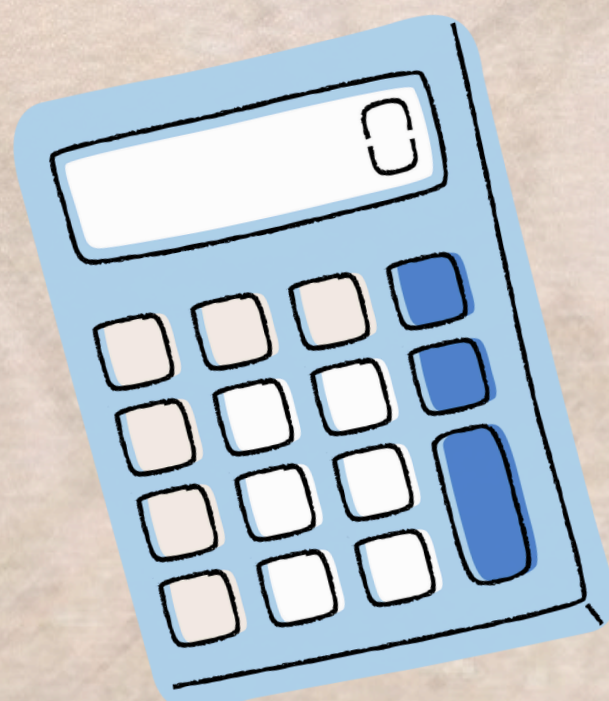


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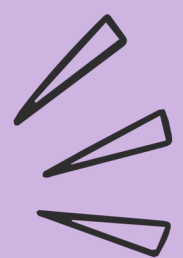

June 7 (registration deadline 5/22)

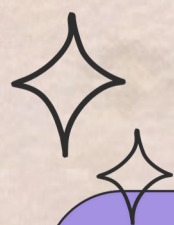

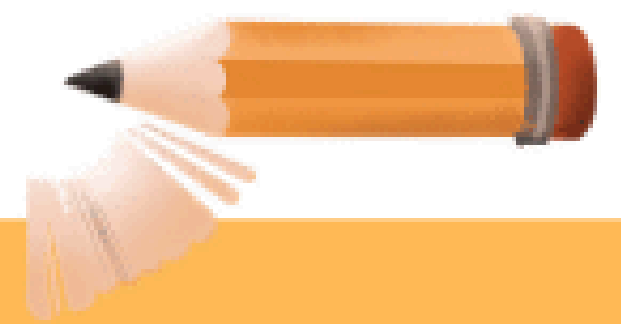
12TH GRADE CENTER

COLLEGE APPLICATION CHECKLIST



Have you checked everything?

1

Get release signed- by yourself if over 18 or a parent/guardian if under 18. Located in center. Return to Mrs. Cooley. You will not be able to proceed further without this step.

2

In Naviance-make sure Colleges are added to "Colleges I am applying to" list- IMPORTANT- make sure you select how you are applying and also due dates.

3

If using Common App- Match Account (link)

- waive FERPA, enter email, match account. If you need/used a fee waiver, you can indicate that on Common App and we will be able to verify this on our end of the application.

4

If recommendations are needed (see each college for info)- go to "Letters of Recommendation" (under Colleges tab)- select teacher, college,etc, Make sure you complete brag sheet (under surveys) to help teachers write letters.

5

To request transcript- go under "College I am Applying to"- click + sign and manage transcripts, Follow prompts.

6

Keep checking your email for any missing items needed and communications from colleges. Let us know how things work out!

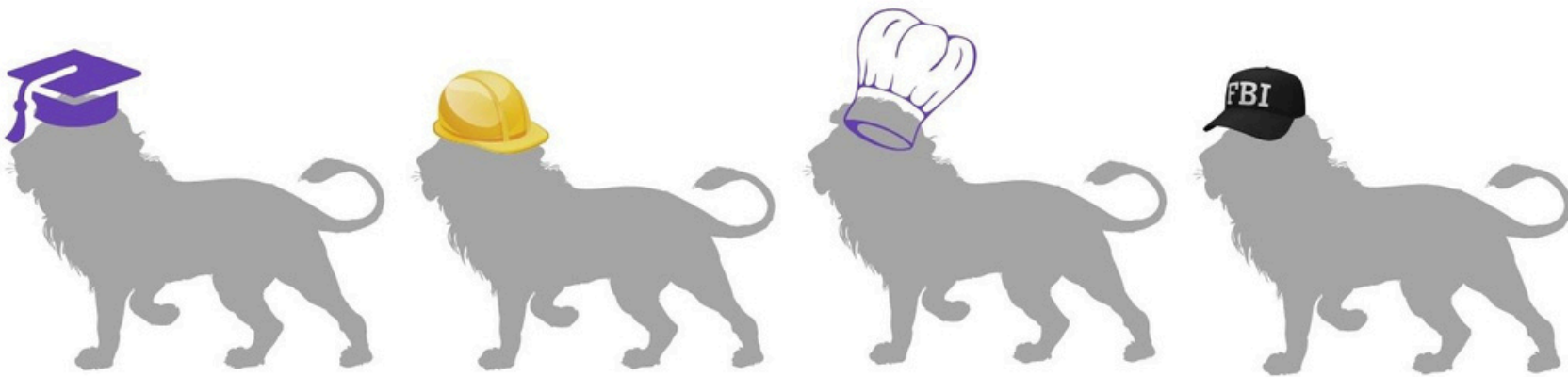

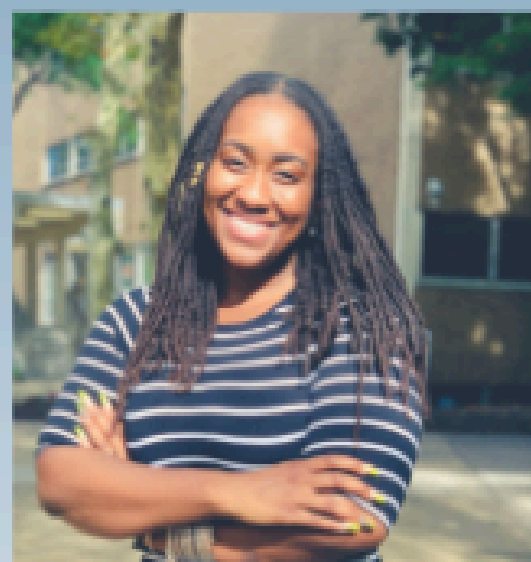
