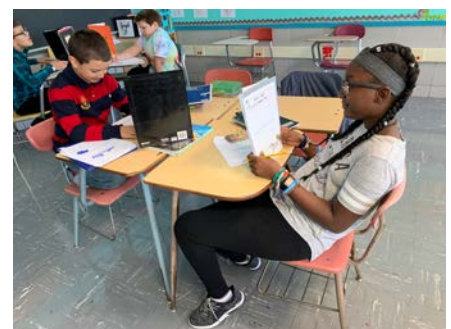
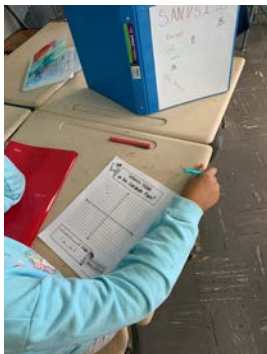
## Custodian Appreciation Day!

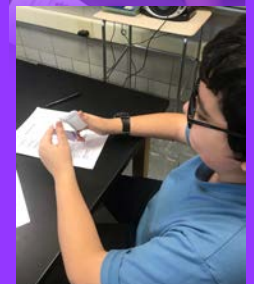
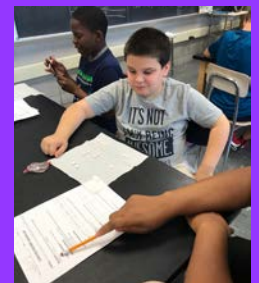


## NEWS FROM SEMINAR

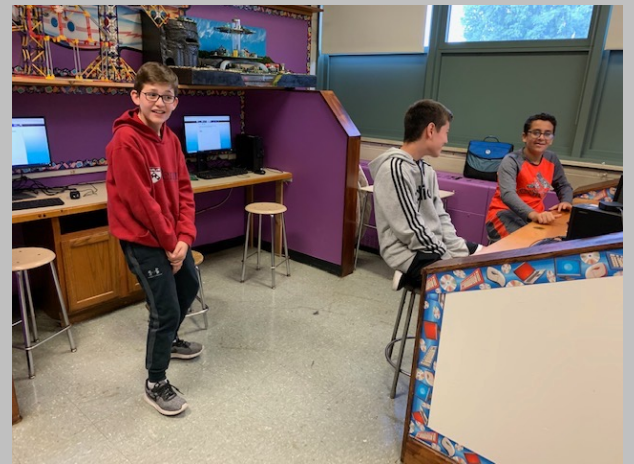


# MATH MADNESS

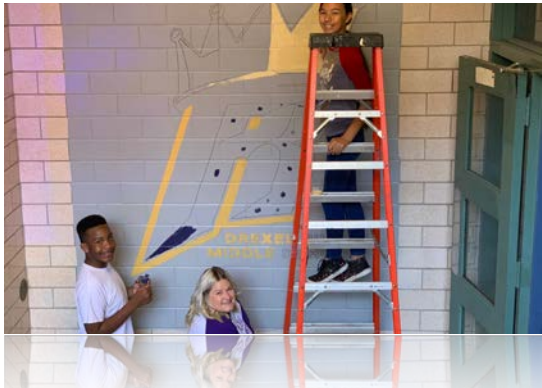
