

Upper Darby School District is taking every precaution for the health and safety of our students and has implemented a series of safety and PPE protocols in our daily transportation operations. The transportation department will require the support of parents and students to ensure a safe return of students. We have listed some of the most important parts of our full health and safety plan for a safe reopening of schools.

Student Responsibilities -

- Parents/Guardians are required to take the temperature of every child and confirm the child is symptom-free before boarding the school bus.
- Students are required to maintain social distancing at the bus stop to avoid spreading of the virus.
- Students are required to wear a mask/face covering while on the school bus.
- Students are urged to maintain the highest personal hygiene.

UDSD Promise -

- Upper Darby School District has assigned seats to every eligible student in order to maximize the distance between students. Siblings will be assigned to the same bench.
- Our buses are cleaned and disinfected daily to maintain health and safety standards for all students.
- Transportation department checks the body temperature for each driver before every shift.
- All riders including drivers and attendants would be required to wear a face mask while on a school bus.
