- Their UDSD Google account is the only account associated with Schoology.
- UDSD Google credentials **MUST** be used to access the lessons on Schoology.



K-2 Grade Student Usernames and Passwords

- Usernames are their 6 digit student ID #/lunch # followed by @student.upperdarbysd.org
 - For example: 123456@student.upperdarbysd.org
- Passwords are their 8 digit birthdate
 - 01012014 (January 01, 2014)
 - Note: The birthday day & month are both 2 digits.
- If your child has lost or forgotten their password please email: familyschoologysupport@upperdarbysd.org


3rd - 12th Grade Student Usernames and Passwords

- Usernames are their student ID #(lunch #) followed by @student.upperdarbysd.org.
- Passwords have been assigned to students.




