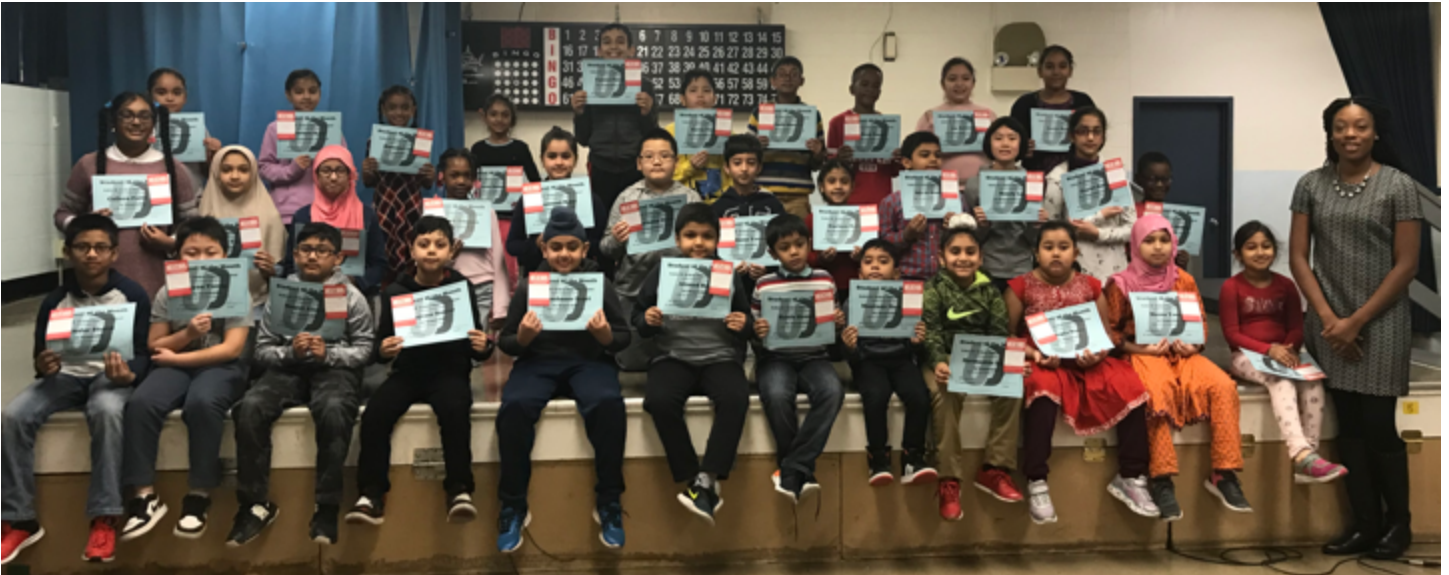

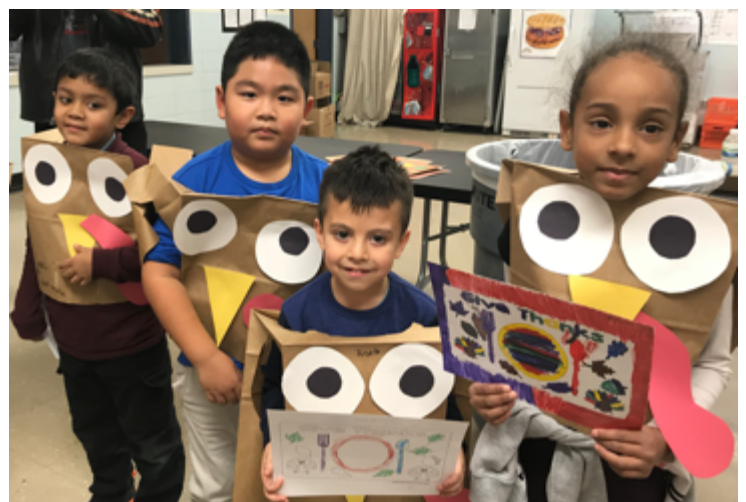

*Students were treated to some of the trimmings of a traditional Thanksgiving dinner, including cranberry, pumpkin pie, stuffing and corn bread.*





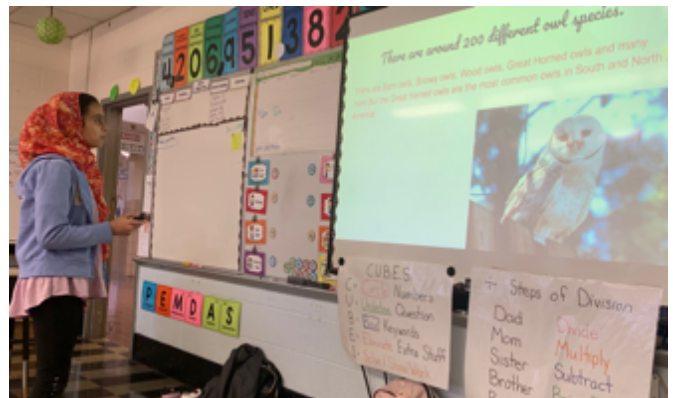
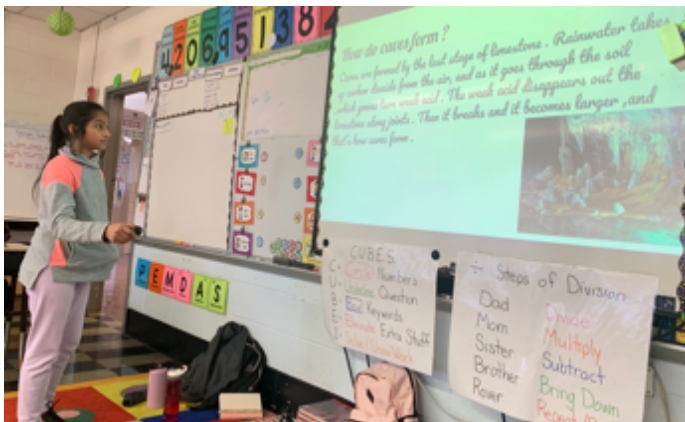
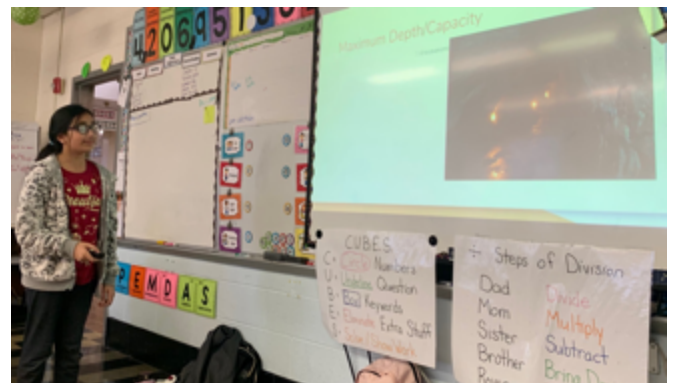
