Early Dismissal Tomorrow

Just a reminder that tomorrow, Thursday December 15, 2022, is an early dismissal day. Students are dismissed at 1:30 PM.

Dismissal

The administration team and I are in the process of making adjustments to our dismissal procedures. We have found that the courtyard is very crowded in the afternoons. This is partially due to transportation delays, partially due to the walkers/car riders that do not leave at dismissal time. As a starting point, the courtyard is now closed at dismissal. Students that walk, or get picked up, are being asked to leave out of the door closest to their last period class, or their locker. Bus students will wait in the cafeteria until their bus arrives. We will continue to adjust dismissal procedures keeping in line with the safety and comfort of all of our students.
