Students were recognized for demonstrating *Trustworthiness* in the month of October. More students were recognized as Golden Ticket winners, too!

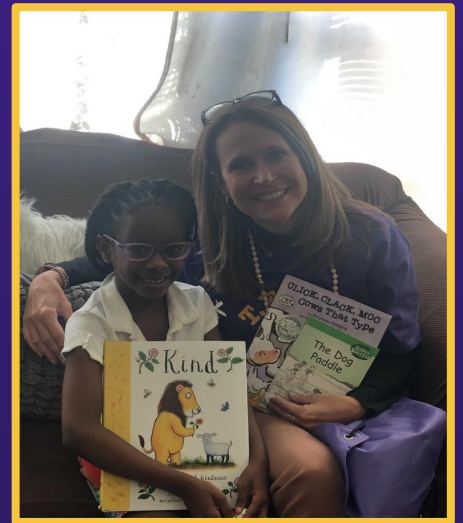

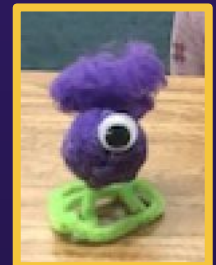
5th Grade

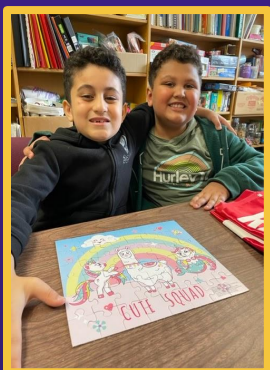


Fire Prevention Week
