

Fourth Graders created stream trays in Science and explore how water can change the land. They also used ice blocks, clay, and sand to model the movement of glaciers on land.

































5th Grade

3rd Grade


Welcome to a new school year! Third grade is a busy grade at Highland Park. We practiced our Royal
