Homeless Prevention

To prevent the loss of existing housing or quickly re-house an already homeless household, qualified Delaware County residents can receive financial assistance to avoid eviction or move them into a new residence. To apply for financial assistance, please come in for an assessment at our office located at 1414 Meetinghouse Road in Boothwyn, PA. Assessments are conducted Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. (no appointments required).

Please bring the following documentation to the assessment:

- 1. PA State ID for all household members 18 years of age or older
- 2. Social Security Cards for all household members
- 3. Proof of all household income
- 4. Proof of eviction if applicable
- 5. Copy of lease

Utility Assistance

Community Action Agency of Delaware County, Inc. (CAADC, Inc.) partners with PECO Energy Company to provide comprehensive services and information designed to increase household efficiency, reduce energy costs, and conserve energy. Grants are available to assist eligible Delaware County residents with payment of past due PECO bills and/or to restore service. Eligible residents can receive financial assistance one time over a 24 month period. To apply for financial assistance, please come in to our office located at 1414 Meetinghouse Road in Boothwyn, PA. You can apply for assistance Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. (no appointments required). Please bring the following documentation when you come to apply:

- 1. PA State ID for all household members 18 years of age or older
- 2. Social Security Cards for all household members
- Proof of all household income
- 4. Shut-off notice from PECO Energy Company

Helping Hand Program

Aqua PA, in partnership with CAADC, Inc., provides payment arrangements with customers who have a past due bill of \$110 or more. The bill must be at least 30 days past due and a good faith payment is required in the amount determined by Aqua PA.
