

Parent Access to schoolology[®]

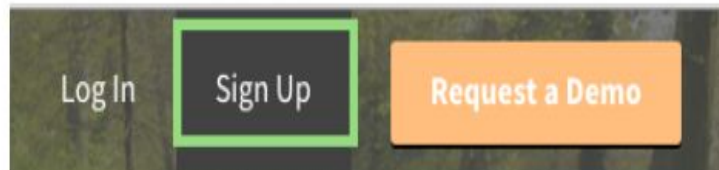
For the 2016-17 school year, all UDHS students have been given accounts in a learning management system called Schoolology.

What is Schoolology? Teachers can use Schoolology to post their classroom materials online; provide a safe forum for students to discuss their ideas and collaborate on projects; and to assign and collect homework electronically. It helps students stay organized and it keeps the class connected.

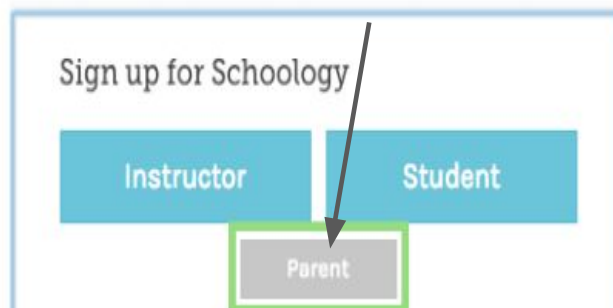
- **Are all teachers using Schoolology?** This semester is a transition semester as we get acquainted with this new online system. Some teachers have started using Schoolology to post assignments, and some are still posting assignments on their pages on the District website. We expect to utilize Schoolology school-wide for the second semester of the 2016-17 school year.
- **How can parents access Schoolology?** Parents can use the following directions to create a parent account. If a student's teacher is using Schoolology, they can give your child the Parent Access Code to bring home. This code will allow you to see their Schoolology activity and the course assignments. Parents can only see their own child's Schoolology activity - not other students. Parents can see multiple children from within their Parent account, but each child must give you their own unique code.
- **Please continue to use Home Access Center to see student grades.**

A How to Create a Parent Account in Schoolology:

1. In your browser, navigate to app.schoolology.com.
2. In the top right corner of the screen, click **Sign Up**

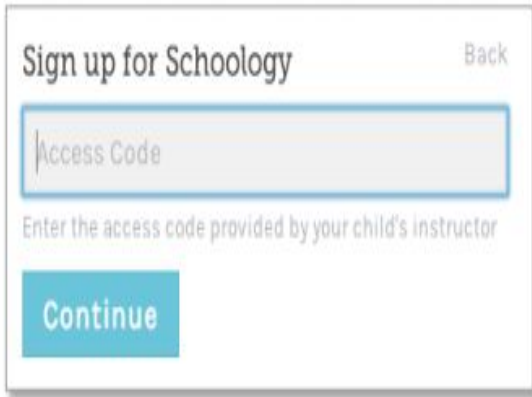


3. Click **Parent**



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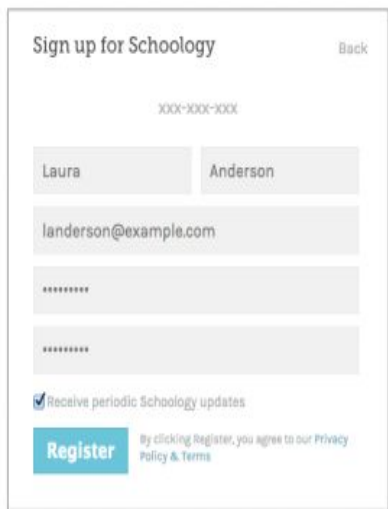
4. You should have received a Parent Access Code from your child's school. Enter that code here:



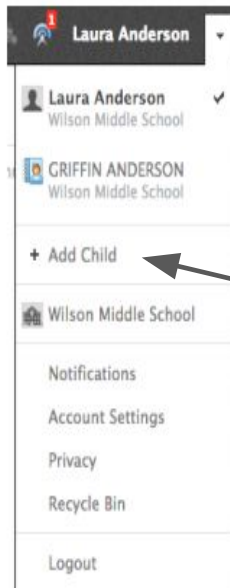
