SCIENCE LABORATORY GENERAL SAFETY REGULATIONS

- 1. All students must adhere strictly to all lab procedures given BEFORE, DURING, and AFTER all laboratory activities.
- 2. Lab aprons must be worn and tied in the back at all times in the laboratory.
- 3. Safety glasses/goggles (supplied by the school) MUST be worn at all times. Eye glasses may not be substituted for safety glasses.
- 4. Long hair must be securely tied back.
- 5. All work areas must be clear of all unnecessary items (e.g. handbags, textbooks, book bags, extraneous papers, etc.).
- 6. Loose clothing, baggy sleeves, and/or coats may not be worn in the lab.
- 7. Students should know the location and proper use of the fire extinguisher, fire blanket, and eye wash.
- 8. Students should NEVER reach over an open flame.
- 9. Students should extinguish all burner flames when not in use (even if it will be used later).
- 10. Students should dispose of experimental materials as directed by teacher.
- 11. Students are NEVER to taste, eat, or drink anything in lab.
- 12. All chemicals that come in contact with the skin need to be washed off immediately with water. NOTIFY teacher for further safety instructions.
- 13. Students are to handle sharp dissecting tools with extra care.
- 14. Students are to wash hands thoroughly before leaving the laboratory.
