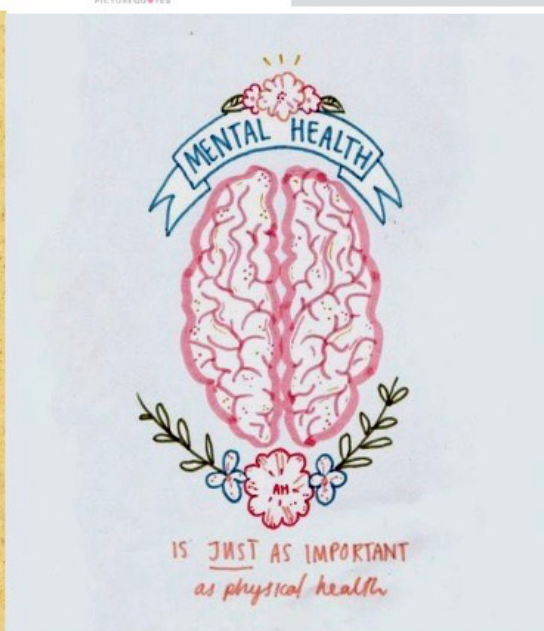
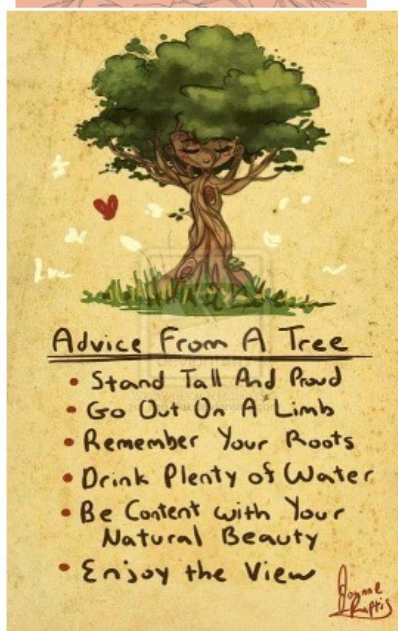

Art Q: What do artists say when they greet each other?

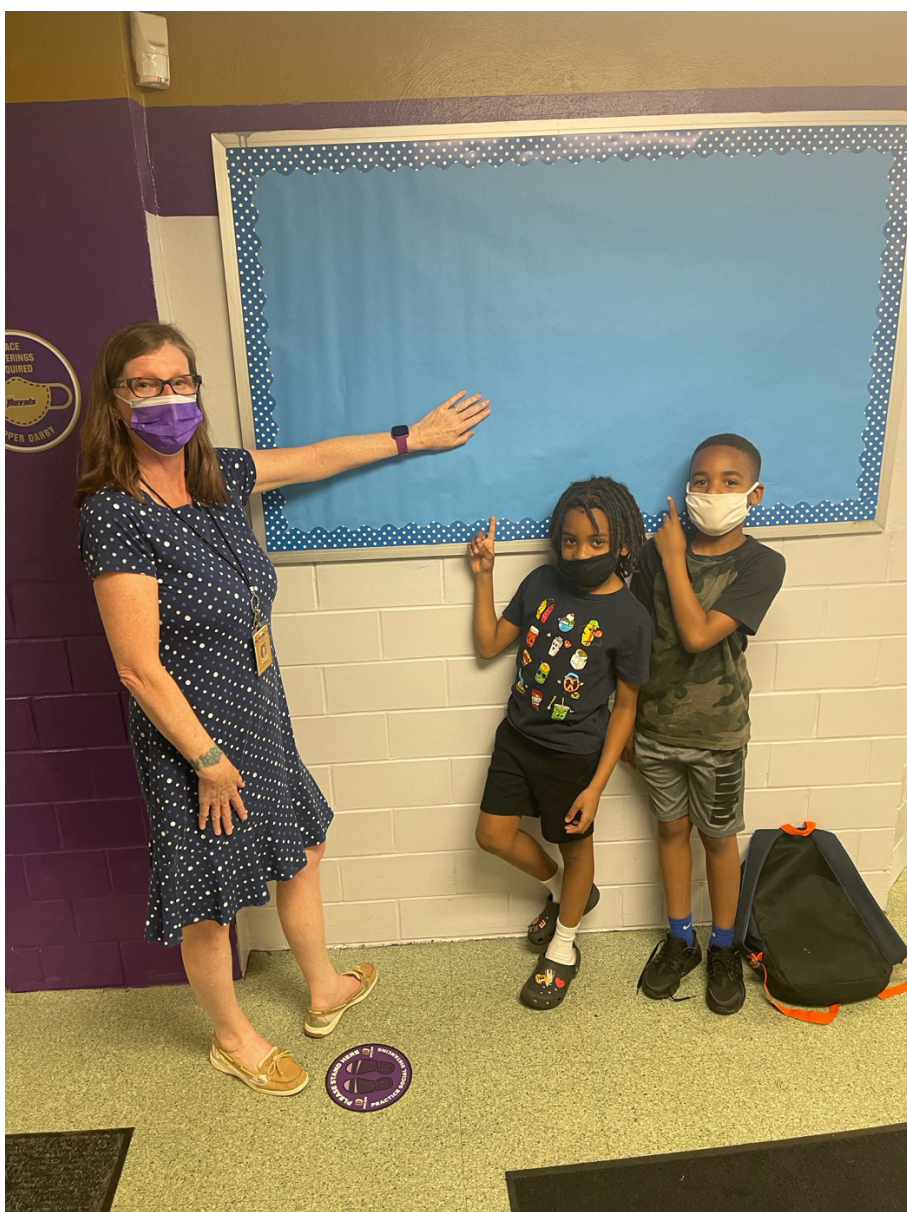

He was ready to start summer!

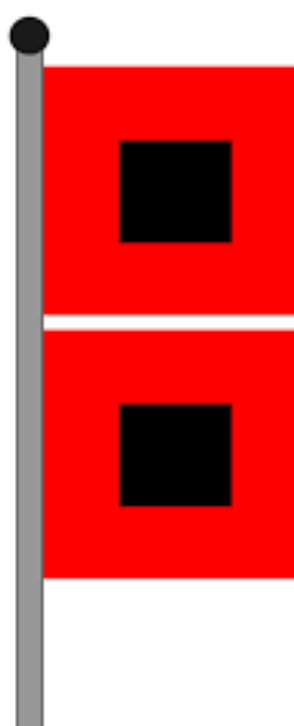

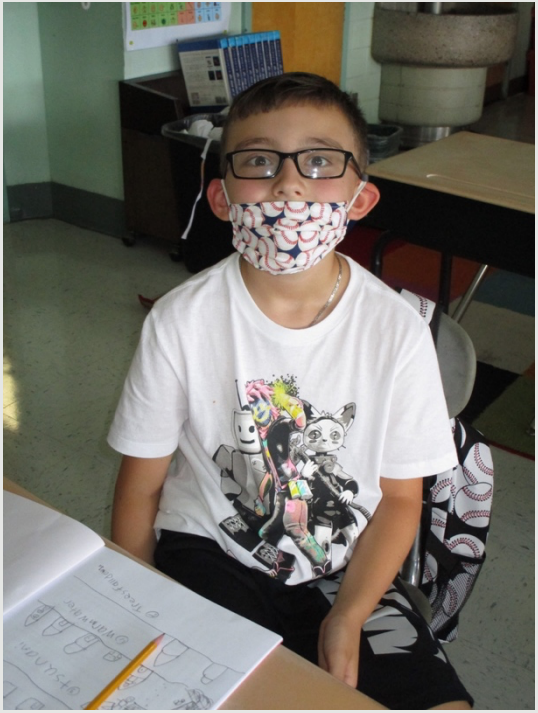
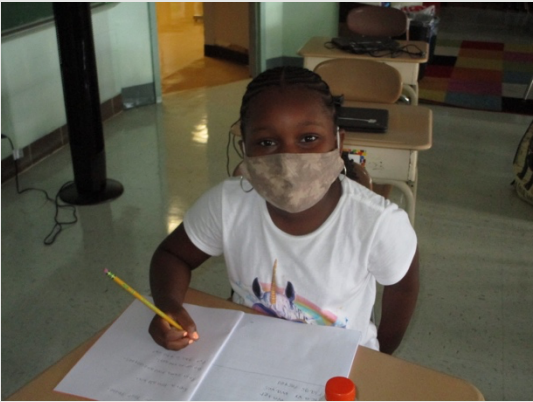
