It is with great pleasure that I officially welcome you to the 2020-2021 school year. **Students' virtual first day of school is August 31, 2020.**

As this school year presents a new normal, due to COVID-19 health guidance and social distancing safety measures, the highly qualified and devoted Primos educators are working extensively to ensure our students will be presented with learning opportunities that will allow students to thrive and grow. Our mission at Primos Elementary School is to foster a community of learners that strive for continuous improvement and growth. During these unprecedented times I am committed to maintaining the highest standards so that there will be no shortage of opportunities for your child(ren) to feel challenged on a daily basis with high quality instruction, and have a wide variety of options to stay connected to their school community and peers.

Overview of UDSD Virtual Learning Plan

- On August 4, 2020 the Board voted to shift to virtual learning for the start of the 2020-2021 school year, with a plan to reevaluate at the end of September and November.
- Students will attend synchronous and asynchronous instructional sessions each week. Reading, mathematics, and related arts instruction will be provided synchronously, with live teacher support, and social studies will be provided asynchronously, through the Schoology platform.
- Students will be separated into 2 cohorts (AM & PM). Families with multiple elementary aged children will be in the same cohort. Your child(ren)'s cohort was previously emailed to you by Frank Salerno, Director of Elementary Education. You can also view your child's cohort assignment through this interactive map: Interactive Cohort Map. Cohort 1 is identified in blue and these students are a part of the AM synchronous, live teacher support, session. Cohort 2 is identified in yellow and these students are a part of the PM synchronous, live teacher support, session.
- AM session 8:30AM to 11:00AM
- PM session 1:00 PM to 3:30PM

- On <u>August 19, 2020</u> and <u>August 26, 2020</u> Primos families will be able to pick up and borrow a district Chromebook at Primos from 9AM-12PM, 1PM-4PM, and 5PM-7PM.
 - o Please park on the side of the building and enter the patio doors, proceed to the cafeteria, pick up a Chromebook, and exit through the front door.
- All students will have an opportunity to obtain consumable curriculum materials, such as textbooks and workbooks. We will provide families with curriculum material retrieval dates. More information will be communicated to families prior to August 31st regarding the pickup of student materials.
