Good Morning Upper Darby School District Families,

We are writing to provide you with an update regarding when P-EBT cards will be issued and received. The Pandemic-EBT cards are issued in phases by the state. Some of our students who receive SNAP or TANF benefits may have already received theirs. The rest of our students who attend one of our 14 schools will receive theirs by the end of July. The Electronic Benefit Transfer cards (EBT) are like a debit card, and can be used to buy food. The cards are mailed directly by the state. If you do not receive a card for your child by July 30th, you may submit an inquiry to the state at <https://www.emergencymealsurvey.com/PA>.

We understand the frustration and confusion the delay might be causing for you and your family. Please understand that the District does not manage this process and has no control over distribution of funds. The only thing the District contributed to this process was submitting a list of our active students. We hope that all families will continue to take advantage of the free breakfast and lunches that are provided by the district, available on Mondays and Wednesdays between 9:30-11:00 at Bywood, Stonehurst, Highland Park, Garrettford, Hillcrest and Westbrook Park.
