COVID-19 Current Food Preparation and Delivery Response Plan

Grab and Go Breakfast and Lunch

Dates: March 17, 18, 19, 20, 23, 24, 25, 26, and 27

Time: 10AM-11AM

Good afternoon Upper Darby School District Families, Teachers and Staff,

This is Dr. Dan McGarry, Superintendent of Schools, reaching out to you with an update on our handling of the Governor's state-wide school closure announcement as a result of Coronavirus/COVID-19. On Tuesday, March 17, 2020 from 10AM-11AM, the District will begin providing both breakfast and lunch for students 18 years old and younger. We have provided an emergency grab and go food plan at the elementary school locations listed in the email and [document](#) accompanying this message.

Aramark will prepare all food at Upper Darby High School. We will begin delivering food to specific elementary locations starting **Tuesday, March 17 at 10AM**. We will utilize

our bus drivers for delivery and distribution. Each bus will include multiple drivers/assistants in order to facilitate our grab and go program. This will also ensure we have enough employees to distribute food at each location. Both breakfast and lunch will be provided from **10AM to 11AM**. We will also have **crossing guards** at their normal locations from 9:45AM-11AM along with **school security** on location for assistance. If you are unsure as to your food pickup location, please refer to the visual examples listed in the email and document accompanying this communication.

Middle School and High School Food Locations

- Beverly Hills Middle School students should pick up breakfast and lunch at the closest elementary school to their home: Bywood Elementary School, Highland Park Elementary School, and/or Stonehurst Hills Elementary School.

- Drexel Hill Middle School students should pick up breakfast and lunch at the closest elementary school to their home: Aronimink, Charles Kelley Elementary School, Garrettford Elementary School, Hillcrest Elementary School, Primos Elementary School, Westbrook Park Elementary School.
- Upper Darby High School students should pick up breakfast and lunch at an elementary school food location closest to their home.

We have provided visual examples in the document attached to this communication for each of the identified elementary food locations. The school listed in the large circle is the elementary food location. The schools listed to the right of elementary school food location are schools whose neighborhoods may be closest to the identified elementary listed in the larger circle. Grab and go lunches will be provided at each of the listed elementary school food locations from **10AM to 11AM**.

We urge you to continue to be vigilant and monitor your children for signs of illness and to recognize signs of illness in yourself. Please contact your medical health care provider with any symptoms. This is an ever-changing situation, so please be patient with us as we navigate this very complex emergency response.
