Good Afternoon Upper Darby School District Community,

This is Superintendent of Schools Dr. Dan McGarry with another update. Our goal is to be flexible as we transition all of our students to virtual learning during the state-mandated school closure. We know that technical issues with our Learning Management System (LMS), Schoology, are causing frustration for you and your family as you attempt to comply with the Emergency School Closing Educational Opportunities Plan's mandatory phase. As I stated in yesterday's update, students will not be penalized for attendance or inability to participate in online learning as Schoology works through these issues.

We have decided to extend the due date for work completion for the week of March 30, 2020 to April 3, 2020 though Spring Break. This means that work from this past week will not be due until 3:00 PM on Friday, April 10th. As a reminder, attendance is based upon completion of work. Therefore, attendance for this week will not be taken until after 3:00 PM on Friday, April 10, 2020.

Please remember that during Spring Break teachers will not be available for questions or for help. We are, therefore, urging students to communicate with teachers as much as possible prior to April 3rd with any questions they may have regarding work.
