Good Evening Upper Darby School District Community,

This is Superintendent of Schools Dr. Dan McGarry with another update. Our goal is to be flexible as possible as we have transitioned all of our students to virtual learning during the state-mandated school closure. We know that technical issues with our Learning Management System (LMS), Schoology, are causing frustration for you and your family as you attempt to comply with the Emergency School Closing Educational Opportunities Plan's mandatory phase. As I stated in yesterday's update, students will not be penalized for attendance or inability to participate in online learning as Schoology works through these issues.

I am happy to report that over 88% of the students in the District have been accessing the educational opportunities we have been providing. The data clearly indicate that our Upper Darby Royals are committed to learning.
