Good evening, Upper Darby School District Staff & Families,

We are writing to provide you with another update regarding our pandemic reopening of schools plan. On November 10th, Dr. McGarry provided his monthly report to the Board of School Directors. During his report, he discussed a possible return to in-person instruction for students in grades K-3 in a flexible cohort model on January 19, 2021. This decision will be based on positivity rate and the number of incidences per 100,000 residents following winter break. The District will provide families with a decision regarding reopening of schools in the flexible/in-person, cohort instructional model two weeks in advance of any final decision.
