The Upper Darby School District parents and community are invited to review the application, which is posted on our website at <https://www.upperdarbysd.org/Domain/2061>. The District has held two hearings to consider the application.

Please include your first and last name and your address in your email. You must be a resident of the Upper Darby School District (Upper Darby Township, Clifton Heights Borough, or Millbourne Borough) in order for your comment to be read publicly at the meetings.

Comments received up to the close of the public comment period will be read into or included in the record. Public comments will be considered up until the voting meeting.
