First off, please understand that final grades for the second semester are due from teachers by noon on Wednesday, June 7th. Any seniors that do not meet graduation requirements will be contacted by Thursday at noon as to their graduation status.

Seniors that are graduating and taking part in the ceremony on Monday, June 12th <u>MUST</u> attend the graduation rehearsal on Friday, June 9th.

Details for Friday, June 9th:

- Seniors are encouraged to wear their Class of 2023 Senior Things shirts!...we still have shirts that have never been picked up. They are in the senior center.
- Seniors must be checked into their assigned homeroom by 11:45am (*Please note that seniors have to find their own way to the high school that day.)
- There will be a short video in homeroom before seniors transition to the gym for the remainder of the rehearsal
- Rehearsal should take an hour or less...as long as everyone cooperates and listens to Ms. Kottan!
- After rehearsal, seniors will return to their assigned homeroom to receive their cap/gown and five (5) tickets
- Students with obligations (Chromebooks, Act 158, Work based learning, textbooks, uniforms, etc.) will
 not be able to receive their cap/gown and tickets until all obligations have been satisfied.
 - · An email with specific obligations will go out by Wednesday morning
 - We will have rooms set up in the hallway between the senior center and library for satisfying obligations starting at 9:30 on Friday, June 9th
 - Seniors that owe \$52 for the cap/gown can see Mr. Peterkin this week with their payment

Details for Monday, June 12th:

Seniors must report to their assigned HR at UDHS by 7:30am...please be on time

- We will be boarding buses starting at 8:45, so there is a lot of organizing to be done in homeroom
- Students should be in dress code and in their cap & gowns and ready to load buses
- Do not bring anything that you would need to carry on Monday...your hands should be empty for processing and accepting the diploma

We need everyone's cooperation for these two events to run smoothly. Almost 1,000 students will be graduating next Monday, so we all need to be patient, kind and respectful.
