# Senior Appreciation Day

- Scheduled for THIS Thursday, May 25th during the school day

## **Graduation**

- <u>Chromebook Collection Plan:</u> We will start collecting Chromebooks from seniors on Thursday, June 1st.
  - In-person seniors will hand in their Chromebook to the teacher of the last scheduled class (i.e. If your last class is Block 2, then you would hand in the device to your Block 2 teacher)
  - Virtual & early Grad seniors will need to come up to the building to hand in their device at the senior center on Wednesday, June 7th

#### \*If a student needs to hold onto their Chromebook through finals, they will receive a reminder that it is their responsibility to hand in the Chromebook at the senior center on Wednesday, June 7th

- Emails/phone calls will go out on Wednesday, June 7th for any senior that has not handed in their district issued device. Those students will not receive their cap & gown or their graduation tickets on June 9th UNTIL the obligation has been satisfied.
- <u>Cap & Gown Orders</u>: If you have not yet done so, you have just over a week to reserve your cap & gown for graduation, which can be completed using the Google form <u>HERE</u>.
  (\*Everyone receives their cap & gown on June 9th once ALL obligations have been satisfied.)
- <u>Name Pronunciation for Graduation:</u> If you have not done so yet, please use the Google form <u>HERE</u> to upload your name spelled out phonetically. You can also upload a recording of yourself saying your name. This will enable your counselor to start practicing for June 12th!
- <u>Transportation BACK from Temple:</u> All seniors will be riding UD buses to Temple on the morning of June 12th. We expect that the majority of graduates will be leaving Temple with family/friends. However, for those students who will need transportation back AFTER the ceremony, please complete this short survey <u>HERE</u>. We need to know how many students will need transportation so that we have enough bussing.
