Senior Prom/After Prom

- Seniors attending prom must be **checked in by 8PM** tomorrow evening
- If something comes up and you are unable to attend, your parent must email me (or call and leave a voicemail at 610.622.7000 x2325) so that I am aware and can notate the change.
- After 8PM, myself and other administrators will be calling parents for anyone that has not shown up to check on their status and make sure that they are safe.
- In addition to their ticket(s), students are reminded that they and their guest (if bringing one) need to have either a student ID for UDHS (or the school that they attend) OR a valid driver's license for check-in.
- The earliest that students and their guests will be permitted to leave prom is **10:45PM**

- Please RSVP [HERE](#) for After Prom by tonight at 11:59PM. I need to pull a list of students who are attending.

- Remember that all seniors (with 85 or more royal points) may attend after prom even if they did not attend prom, but you must sign up on the Google form above!
- If you signed up and are now NOT attending, your parent must email me that you are no longer attending.
- As with prom, the parents of those students that have not checked into after prom by midnight will be called as a safety measure...believe me, your parent does not want to be awakened, so be on time!

Graduation

- **Senior Homerooms:** I will be sending an email on Monday to all seniors with their assigned graduation homeroom. This room will (most likely) be different from the homeroom on your schedule, so please read carefully. Instructions will accompany that email detailing the plans for Friday's rehearsal and report time for the big day!!
- **Chromebook Collection Plan:** At this point Chromebooks AND chargers will need to be turned in during the following times **at the senior center:**

*Any Chromebook not turned in by Wednesday will become an obligation. Students with outstanding obligations as of Friday, June 9th will not be given their cap & gown and their graduation tickets, which means they cannot participate in the ceremony on June 12th.

*****An email will be going out next week with ALL outstanding obligations (library books, textbooks, uniforms, fines, Chromebooks and chargers, etc.) that are owed by seniors. If you do not receive the email, then you have no obligations to your name.***

- **Cap & Gown Orders:** I have extended the opportunity to reserve a cap and gown until Monday, June 5th at noon. After that, we cannot guarantee that we will have the caps and gowns by Friday for distribution. You can reserve your item(s) using the Google form [HERE](#). (*Everyone receives their cap & gown on June 9th once ALL obligations have been satisfied.)
- **Name Pronunciation for Graduation:** If you have not done so yet, please use the Google form [HERE](#) to upload your name spelled out phonetically. You can also upload a recording of yourself saying your name. This will enable your counselor to start practicing for June 12th!
- **Transportation BACK from Temple:** All seniors will be riding UD buses to Temple on the morning of June 12th. We expect that the majority of graduates will be leaving Temple with family/friends. However, for those students who will need transportation back AFTER the ceremony, please complete this short survey [HERE](#). We need to know how many students will need transportation so that we have enough bussing.
