\*Any emergency school closing dates that bring the total number of student days or hours below the state minimum of 180 days or 450 Kindergarten hours, 900 elementary hours, and 990 secondary hours, will be added to the calendar at the discretion of the School Board of Directors.

\*School District personnel will follow district-established communication protocols in the event of an emergency school closing due to weather conditions. When possible, the district will give 24-hour notice to families for weather-related school schedule adjustments.

\*The Upper Darby School District has been approved by the Pennsylvania Department of Education (PDE) to use up to five Flexible Instructional Days (FID) per school year. A FID day allows our school district to deliver an alternate approach to instruction if a circumstance arises that prevents instruction in a traditional classroom. Advanced notice will be provided to ensure students and staff can be prepared to participate in a non-traditional learning environment.
