Developmental Writing Continuum Level		
1	Emerging: Makes uncontrolled or unidentifiable scribbling	Not Yet Proficient (NYP)
2	Pictorial: Imitates writing. Draws somewhat recognizable picture. Tells about picture.	
3	Pre-communicative: Writes to convey message; attempts to read it back. Uses letter like forms and/or random letter strings. Prints occasional known word.	
4	Semi-phonetic: Correctly uses some letters to match sounds. May use one beginning letter to write a word. Writes from left to right (may contain some reversals).	
5	Phonetic: Represents beginning and ending consonant sounds. Spells some high-frequency words correctly in sentences. Includes some vowels. Writes more than one sentence.	Proficient (P)
6	Transitional: Correctly spells many high frequency words in sentences. Uses vowels in most syllables. Begins to use simple punctuation. Writes two or more varying sentences.
