The Board of School Directors values the unique contributions made by parents/guardian volunteers to the educational and extracurricular programs of the school district. Accordingly, the Board encourages the use of parent/guardian volunteers, subject to certain requirements and procedures as set forth in the <u>Upper</u> <u>Darby School District Volunteers Policy</u> (https://bit.ly/38efMRB). How much does it cost to become a school volunteer?

For volunteers, the state of Pennsylvania has waived the cost of the state criminal check as well as the child abuse check. The cost of the FBI clearance is \$28.75 and the volunteer is responsible for that expense.

How do I become a school volunteer?

STEP 1	To be considered as a school parent volunteer in Upper Darby School District, you must contact the Principal of the school where you wish to volunteer to express interest.
STEP 2	All potential District volunteers are required to complete a <u>Non-Staff</u> <u>Volunteer Application (916-AR-1</u>). See the attached application or visit <u>https://bit.ly/38erRWT.</u> Submit the completed application to your child's Principal for review and signature. Collect the signed application from the Principal for inclusion in your Volunteer Application packet.
STEP	 All potential District volunteers are required to submit the following clearances: Act 34 PA State Police Criminal Background Check (https://epatch.state.pa.us/) – NO COST FOR VOLUNTEERS Act 151 Childline Clearance - Child Abuse Clearance (https://www.compass.state.pa.us/cwis/public/home) Once on the PA Child Welfare Information Solution website, you must create an account and establish a log-in. Once you have established an account, follow the instructions to apply for the child abuse clearance. There is NO COST for the clearance for volunteers. You will receive a confirmation email upon completion of your application and after payment is made. Print your Child Abuse Clearance for inclusion in your Volunteer Application Packet. Act 114 FBI Criminal Clearance – Fingerprinting (https://www.identogo.com/locations/pennsylvania) Once on the website, select the digital fingerprint and enter the code 1KG6XN. Act 82 Arrest/Conviction Report and Certification (https://bit.ly/3kvUmoq) Print and complete the form.
