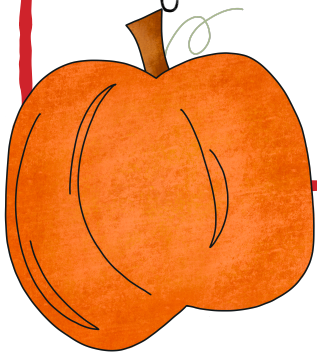
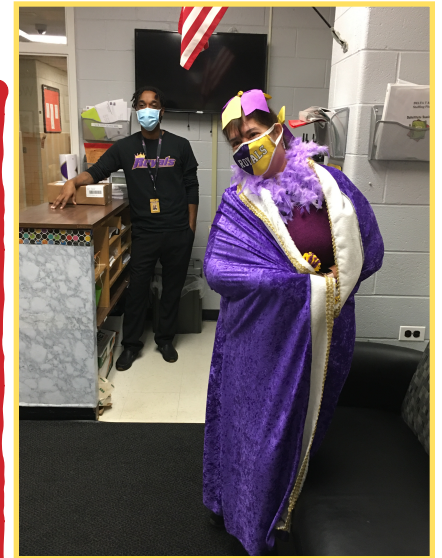
Congratulations Royals for reaching the golden ticket goal in October! We are excited that you earned the Fall Festival Parade!

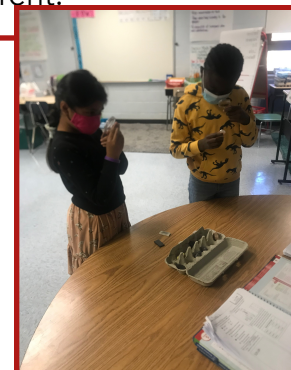
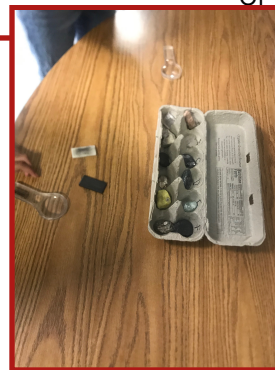

TEACH

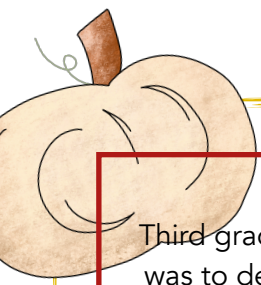
Highland Park's annual TEACH event was another huge success! Teachers enjoyed reading to first grade families!

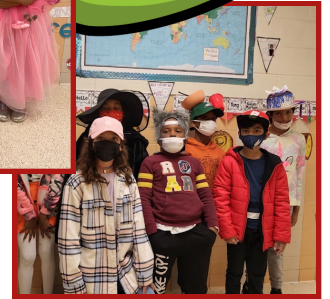
