ATTENDANCE & TRUANCY REVIEW FOR PARENTS

ATTENDANCE POLICY & ABSENT NOTES

- All absences need a written note from a parent/guardian to be marked as "excused"
- Reasons for an Excused Absence:
 - Illness
 - Family Emergency
 - Recovering from an accident/injury
 - Death in the family
 - Vacation (prior approval needed)

- Absent notes must be turned in <u>within 3 days of</u> <u>returning to school</u>
 - Once a student has been absent 10 days or more, a doctor's note or an "Explanation of Absence Form" is required or the absence will be unlawful. This form is provided by the main office.
 - Vacations need to pre approved by the building principal. A letter stating how the trip will be educational needs to be sent to the principal prior to the absence.

Emailing your student's teacher <u>does not</u> count as a written note. If you are providing an absent note via email it must be sent to the above email address^{}

Illegal Absences

If the student is <u>under</u> age 17 \rightarrow It is *legally required* that your child attend school

• Any absence from school <u>without</u> a note from a parent/guardian is considered an "illegal absence" and will be marked as a "Truant" day

3 Illegal Absences:

- An Official Notice of Illegal Absence goes home via email (or US Mail)
- Invites parent/guardian into school for a School Attendance Improvement Plan (SAIP) Meeting

 Goal is to figure out why the student is missing school and how we can best support them

6 Illegal Absences:

- "Habitually Truant" and the consequences could be more severe
- The school district may file a Truancy Citation to go to Truancy Court
 - Judge hears case and decides on a consequence
 - <u>Example</u>: monetary fines, participation in community-based referral, etc.
