



Workouts consist of: Sit-ups Push-ups Pull-ups Standing Broad Jump 600 Yard Run





# 1<sup>st</sup> Annual Turkey Trot Fun!






First grade graders enjoyed the turkey trot put on by the student council! They ran and danced their way into the Thanksgiving break!! A fun time was had by all!!

  - Use the rock, paper, and scissor model but put out a number of fingers when you say, "shoot!" Multiply your number against your partner's number to find the product.


# Fourth Grade Learns about Cyber-Bullying
