**First grade has been working with shapes and their attributes in math. The kids had a great time using their imagination to design a creation while only using a few foam cutouts.**

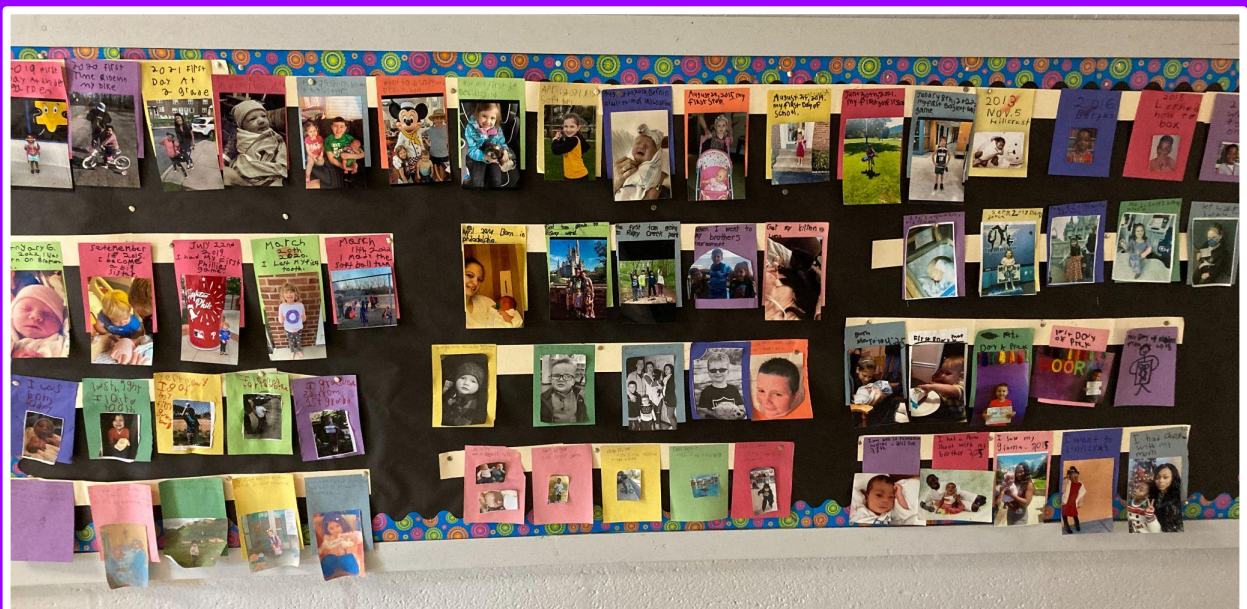




# 2nd Grade News
