PUBLIC NOTICE

Due to the special circumstances surrounding the current COVID-19 crisis, the Board of School Directors (the “Board”) of the Upper Darby School District (the “District”) gives notice that each of its meetings that will occur through the end of August 2020, specifically including the below listed meetings but also any other public meetings which are subsequently scheduled, will take place virtually and shall use the procedures set forth herein and as listed on the District’s publicly available website (<http://www.upperdarbysd.org>). The specific list of meetings includes previously scheduled voting meetings June 2, 2020, July 14, 2020, and August 11, 2020, previously scheduled committee meetings on June 16, 2020, July 28, 2020 and August 25, 2020, and a special meeting, described further below, on June 16, 2020. Each such meeting shall convene at the time previously advertised for such.

The above noted Special Meeting will take place on June 16, 2020 and will convene immediately following the final committee meeting noted on the same date, above. The purpose of this special meeting will be to consider and adopt the District’s annual budget for the 2020-2021 school year and any other matters that may properly be brought before the Board.

Public attendance at each of these meetings shall be limited to remote viewing by means of the District’s YouTube Channel, found at <https://www.youtube.com/channel/UCks7kcuopoCEA-fbmLWy2kw>. Public participation by residents and taxpayers of the District during each of the meetings will occur by email and through phone messages, each of which may be submitted before the Board takes action on the relevant Board Reports (i.e. Curriculum and Instruction, Personnel, etc.) or come to a consensus on agenda items during Committee Meetings. General public comments for regular Board Meetings must be submitted to the Board by 7:30PM. The public should direct all emailed comments for all meetings to committeequestions@upperdarbysd.org. Phoned comments may be left, subject to the normal 3-minute limit, at 610-789-7200, ext. 2000 and will be transcribed. Both emailed and phoned comments must include the commenter’s name and address, and will be provided to Board members in writing for consideration. Virtual meeting attendance information and instructions are also listed on the District’s website, and recordings of the meetings will also be posted there for review by those unable to participate using the above procedures.
