- Yearbook (Mr. Kee) Teachers will be working on yearbooks. Theme and cover due 11/15. Mrs. McCoy is the liaison for yearbook
- RIF will occur on January 16th, will finalize details

Old Business:

- Turkey Trot (Rehak) course has changed, start is now by the new gym and finish by the black top. Races will be staggered because of size.

New Business:

- A Nominating Committee will need to be formed. Meagan Rubino will chair the committee. Kary and Chantell will be on the committee.
- Mr. Kee has been chosen as of the 50 teachers selected to attend the 2 day Victra professional development at the Ron Clark Academy. Ron Clark is one of the influences on Mr. Kee becoming a teacher. The district will not pay for the substitute teacher cost because it is not a district professional development class. Mr. Kee would like the Home and School to pay for the substitute teacher fee while he is in training. The cost would be about \$500. Mr. Kee provided a presentation of what is covered at the Ron Clark Academy and will come back and talk to the Home and School about what he learned. The motion to approve paying the substitute teacher fee passed.
- The Home and School would like to purchase a cell phone and plan to use for electronic purchasing, such as venmo, at school activities. Motion to look at plans passes.
- Mr. Rehak would like to dispose of the miniature golf course used for May Day. It is 25-30 years old, deteriorating, large and cumbersome. It is currently being housed in Mr. Dunn's space and that space is going to be needed for phys ed equipment. It is not used as much and for its intended use at May Day, there would be better options for May Day games. Motion to dispose of equipment passed.
